Questions to ask Solicitors when seeking legal advice

CHILDREN'S MATTERS:

- 1. How long until your first court date?
- 2. How long until my matter will be heard by a Judge (not a Registrar) When is the final hearing likely to start?
- 3. Will a Family Report be required?
- 4. How long until a final judgement is handed down?
- 5. What can I expect to happen on the first court date?
 - a. How long and how much will it cost in legal fees, application fees etc to get to the first court date?
 - b. What documents will need to be prepared?
 - c. Will a Barrister be briefed?
- 6. What does your Solicitor recommend should happen in the interim ie while this matter is proceeding through the Court? How will access be managed?
- 7. What is the approximate cost per letter of a Solicitor lead negotiation?

FINANCIAL MATTERS:

- 8. Percentage **range** i.e. the likely percentage range (worst case to best case) of the asset pool I am likely to get should this matter be determined by the Court having regard to all the relevant factors?

- 10. How long until judgement is handed down?
- 11. What can I expect to happen on the first court date?
